STREATHAM COMMON
Take the tarmac path past the metal gate by the car park.

NORBURY
Take the path through the park.

COUNTRY PARK
Turn right on the main track through the park.

THE START
The route starts at East Croydon station and is designed to be ridden clockwise. Walk your bike to Dingwall Road to start.

PARK ROAD
Follow the blue cycle signs to Gatwick. Park Road is gated and closed to traffic.

RIDDLESDOWN LOOP
The Riddlesdown Loop is an optional extra for all-terrain bikes. Consisting of hillside meadows and woodland teeming with wildlife, it's the closest open countryside to the centre of Croydon. The full 50 mile route crosses the meadow from Tithepit Shaw Lane and continues onto Riddlesdown Road and loops back by Kenley station. You can take a shortcut by turning left on Tithepit Shaw Lane.
